SUBJECT: Announcement and Call for Papers, Fifty-Second U.S. Army Operations Research Symposium (AORS 2014)

1. The U.S. Army Materiel Systems Analysis Activity is hosting the 52nd AORS on 4-5 November 2014 at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland. This year's theme is "Analyses Supporting a Leaner, More Capable Expeditionary 2025 Army."
2. AORS is an excellent opportunity for Army analysts to meet with their colleagues, present their best work, and exchange professional knowledge, experiences, and insights. Nine Enduring/Topical Work Group Sessions are planned: (1) Current Operations, (2) Future Capabilities, (3) Force Development, (4) Sustainment, (5) Resource Analysis, (6) Advances in OR & Technology (R&D), (7) Manpower, Personnel, and Training Analysis, (8) Readiness Analysis, and (9) Operational Energy. Enclosure 1 provides descriptions for each session.
3. Please solicit and encourage attendance and abstracts from civilian and military workforce in organizations under your command. All contractor attendees must be command sponsored, nominated by a Government principal, and be a presenter or a co-author of a presentation.
4. AORS 2014 is unclassified. In the past, representatives have attended from Australia, Canada, the Federal Republic of Germany, France, the Netherlands, New Zealand, the Republic of Korea, and the United Kingdom. Accordingly, all subject material must be releasable to general and international audiences. Therefore, a disclosure form must accompany each article submitted for consideration as part of this year's event. Disclosure forms are provided at Enclosure 2. Please note there are two disclosure forms; a disclosure form must be submitted with each abstract, and a second disclosure form must be submitted with each paper/presentation selected. We are currently working conference approval; abstract submitters will be notified when this determination is made. Parent organizations are expected to fund the trip for their participants.
5. Analysts who would like to present papers should submit abstracts for consideration (with disclosure form) electronically to usarmy.apg.amsaa.list.AMSAA-AORS-2014@mail.mil not later than 7 July 2014. Abstracts should be provided in Microsoft

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Office Word and must follow the Format for Abstracts provided at Enclosure 3. Abstracts will be forwarded to the appropriate session chairs, who will select papers for presentation from the abstracts received. Individuals will be notified of the status of their submissions not later than 5 August 2014. Authors/co-authors of selected abstracts must then submit an electronic copy of the final presentation (with disclosure form) to the AORS staff not later than 30 September 2014.
